APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Ms. Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes for the pre-council and regular meeting of November 5th.

APPROVAL OF BILLS

Mr. Hatfield made a motion to approve payment of the bills in the amount of \$215,781.43.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Bullion made a motion to approve the purchase of one 1995 bucket truck from Mr. Alton Jones in the amount of \$6,500.00 provided that a CDL license is not required to drive it. If purchased this can be paid out of Investment Transfer Funds.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Bullion made a motion to approve the installation of two new street lights. One at 125 Fairlane Drive and the other at 140 Elm Street both in the Longmont Subdivision.

Mr. Bullion made a motion to approve the payment made to The Hiller Companies in the amount of \$589.37. The work was done at the concession stand at the Athletic Complex which is city property so the city will not expect any of the athletic groups to pay any of the bill.

Mr. Bullion made a motion to approve paying Pleasant Grove Youth Football Association in the amount of \$227.06 for supplies and labor for work done at the youth football field.

Mr. Brasseale made a motion to open the floor for a public hearing regarding consideration of changing the municipal voting method from at large to cumulative voting. Actual vote will be at the regular scheduled council meeting on Monday, December 17, 2018.
