**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Ms. Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes for the pre-council and regular meeting of December 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Mr. Houston seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

**APPROVAL OF BILLS**

Mr. Hatfield made a motion to approve payment of the bills in the amount of \$275,886.19.

Ms. Johnson seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

**OFFICERS OF THE CITY REPORTS**

Mr. Hyche reported site work is being done on for the new Dollar General store on 4<sup>th</sup>. Street near the Athletic Complex also a tree was cut at the City Park and three more needs to be cut.

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Mr. Bullion made a motion to authorize Mr. Hyche to get quotes and approve up to \$3,500.00 to have three trees in the park cut and removed. One tree has already been cut and there is three more needing to be cut.

Mr. Houston seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Bullion made a motion to authorize Mr. Hyche to approve the amount of \$200.00 to have a metal grill placed over the concession stand window at the football complex.

Ms. Johnson seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Johnson made a motion authorizing Mr. Hyche to get a list of things to be done in the library and City Hall that needs to be done. The Library needs replacement of windows and an exterior door. Public restrooms in City Hall need renovation. Exterior work of City Hall of replacing some wood trim which has rotted and painting of the front exterior of City Hall.

Mr. Hatfield seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Houston made a motion to approve up to \$4,000.00 to be paid to Jefferson County to have them do striping of streets starting on 9<sup>th</sup>. Street at the traffic light off 5<sup>th</sup>. Avenue and go all the way to 12<sup>th</sup>. Avenue and include 9<sup>th</sup>. Avenue beside Hill's Foodland to the intersection of 9<sup>th</sup>. Street. Payment to be made from Special Gasoline Tax Fund.

Mr. Bullion seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Brasseale made a motion to not hold a public hearing at the meeting tonight since there has been a lawsuit filed against the city. The council cannot discuss anything since a lawsuit has been filed but the public may make comments.

Mr. Houston seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Several residents made comments regarding the subject of changing the voting method for municipal elections.

Comment was made that the 20 MPH speed limit sign has been placed in Woodridge subdivision that was requested but wishes now for the speed limit to be increased.
